- SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 3
- a state agency determines that any other waiver or authorization 5 from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that
- provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the 6

- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 9
