## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the procedure by which a regional water planning group
- 3 is required to make the regional water plan prepared by the group
- 4 available for public inspection.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 16.053(h), Water Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subdivision (3) and adding Subdivision (13) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (3) After the regional water plan is initially
- 10 prepared, the regional water planning group shall, after notice,
- 11 hold at least one public hearing at some central location readily
- 12 accessible to the public within the regional water planning
- 13 area. The group shall make [copies of] the plan available for
- 14 public inspection at least one month before the hearing by posting
- 15 the plan on the group's publicly accessible Internet website and
- 16 may make the plan available for review at other locations
- 17 [providing a copy of the plan in the county courthouse and at least
- 18 one public library of each county having land in the
- 19 region]. Notice for the hearing must [shall] include the address
- 20 of the Internet website on which the plan will be posted [a listing
- 21 of these] and any other location where the plan is available for
- 22 review.
- 23 (13) Each regional water planning group shall maintain
- 24 a publicly accessible Internet website. Each regional water

- 1 planning group shall consider and accommodate residents of the
- 2 regional water planning area who may need assistance accessing the
- 3 regional water plan prepared by the regional water planning group
- 4 because of a lack of access to Internet services.
- 5 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 a regional water plan required to be made available for public
- 7 inspection on or after the effective date of this Act. A regional
- 8 water plan required to be made available for public inspection
- 9 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 10 effect at the time the plan is required to be made available, and
- 11 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
