A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the renewal, expiration, and suspension of driver's
- 3 licenses; increasing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 521.2719 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521.2719. EXPIRED LICENSES. (a) A person may renew an
- 8 expired driver's license if the person's license has not been
- 9 <u>expired for more than 10 years.</u>
- 10 (b) A person whose driver's license has been expired for
- 11 more than 10 years may obtain a new driver's license by complying
- 12 with the requirements and procedures for obtaining an original
- 13 driver's license.
- SECTION 2. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- (1) If a person is applying for the renewal of a driver's
- 17 license that has been expired for more than 90 days, the fee for the
- 18 renewal driver's license is increased by \$20.
- 19 SECTION 3. Chapter 706, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 20 adding Section 706.0045 to read as follows:
- Sec. 706.0045. PERIOD OF DENIAL OF RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S
- 22 LICENSE. (a) Notwithstanding Section 706.004(a) or 706.006(c),
- 23 the department may deny renewal of a person's driver's license under
- 24 this chapter only until the earlier of:

- 1 (1) the date the department receives a clearance
- 2 notice under Section 706.005; or
- 3 (2) the 10th anniversary of the date the department or
- 4 a vendor described by Subsection (b) first received notice under
- 5 this chapter that there was cause to deny renewal of the person's
- 6 driver's license.
- 7 (b) This subsection applies only if the department
- 8 <u>contracts</u> with a vendor under Section 706.008 to implement this
- 9 chapter. Each month, the vendor shall:
- 10 (1) identify each person whose license may no longer
- 11 be denied renewal because of the expiration of the time period
- 12 described by Subsection (a)(2); and
- (2) provide the name of each person identified under
- 14 Subdivision (1) to:
- 15 <u>(A) the department; and</u>
- 16 (B) the applicable court in which the person
- 17 failed to appear based on a complaint or citation or failed to pay
- 18 or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in the
- 19 manner ordered by the court in a matter involving an offense
- 20 described by Section 706.002(a).
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 706.005, Transportation Code, is amended
- 22 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 23 follows:
- 24 (a) A political subdivision shall immediately notify the
- 25 department that there is no cause to continue to deny renewal of a
- 26 person's driver's license based on the person's previous failure to
- 27 appear or failure to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment

- 1 of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the court in a matter
- 2 involving an offense described by Section 706.002(a), on payment of
- 3 a reimbursement fee, or on a finding by the court that the person is
- 4 <u>indigent and not required to pay a reimbursement fee</u>, as provided by
- 5 Section 706.006 and:
- 6 (1) the perfection of an appeal of the case for which
- 7 the warrant of arrest was issued or judgment arose;
- 8 (2) the dismissal of the charge for which the warrant
- 9 of arrest was issued or judgment arose, other than a dismissal with
- 10 prejudice by motion of the appropriate prosecuting attorney for
- 11 lack of evidence;
- 12 (3) the posting of bond or the giving of other security
- 13 to reinstate the charge for which the warrant was issued;
- 14 (4) the payment or discharge of the fine and cost owed
- on an outstanding judgment of the court; [or]
- 16 (5) if the person's license is denied renewal solely
- 17 because of the person's previous failure to appear, the person's
- 18 appearance in court in any manner authorized by law for the
- 19 underlying offense for which the person previously failed to
- 20 appear; or
- 21 (6) any other [suitable] arrangement to satisfy [pay]
- 22 the fine and cost within the court's discretion, including any
- 23 <u>instance in which the person enters into an arrangement with the</u>
- 24 court to satisfy the fine and cost under a payment plan or by
- 25 performing community service.
- 26 (c) A political subdivision that notifies the department
- 27 that there is no cause to continue to deny renewal of a person's

- 1 driver's license under Subsection (a) may notify the department if
- 2 the court subsequently determines the person failed to complete an
- 3 arrangement to satisfy the fine and cost under Subsection (a)(6),
- 4 including failure to complete payment plan installments or failure
- 5 to complete community service. On receiving the necessary
- 6 information from the political subdivision under this subsection,
- 7 the department may deny renewal of the person's driver's license.
- 8 SECTION 5. (a) Sections 521.2719 and 521.421(1),
- 9 Transportation Code, as added by this Act, apply only to an
- 10 application for a renewal driver's license that is submitted on or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act. An application that is
- 12 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 13 law in effect when the application was submitted, and the former law
- 14 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 (b) Section 706.0045, Transportation Code, as added by this
- 16 Act, applies to a determination to deny renewal of a driver's
- 17 license that is made by the Department of Public Safety of the State
- 18 of Texas before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
