Section 302.252(1), Labor Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 7 (1) "Industry-recognized apprenticeship program" means a training program that [+ 8 [(A) provides on-the-job training, preparatory 9 instruction, supplementary instruction, or related instruction in 10 -occupation that has been recognized as an apprenticeable 11 12 occupation by the Office of Apprenticeship of the United States Department of Labor; or 13 14 [(B)] is certified by the commission as an industry-recognized apprenticeship program [by a third-party 15 certifier that has received from the United States Department of 16 Labor a favorable determination of qualification to award that 17 18 certification]. SECTION 2. Section 302.257, Labor Code, is amended by 19 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 20 21 follows: 22 (a) The commission shall adopt rules to administer and 23 enforce this subchapter, including rules establishing the criteria and process for the commission to certify a training program as an 24

industry-recognized apprenticeship program for purposes of this 1 2 subchapter. 3 (a-1) The certification criteria established under Subsection (a) must include that the training program: 4 5 (1) lead to the attainment of skills that: 6 (A) are customarily learned in a practical way through a structured, systematic program of on-the-job supervised 7 8 training; and 9 (B) are clearly identified and commonly 10 recognized throughout an industry; (2) involve manual, mechanical, or technical skills or 11 knowledge requiring significant on-the-job work experience; and 12 (3) require related instruction to supplement the 13 14 on-the-job training. 15 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act, the Texas Workforce Commission shall adopt the rules 16 17 required by Section 302.257, Labor Code, as amended by this Act. SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 18 to a grant awarded under Subchapter I, Chapter 302, Labor Code, on 19 or after the effective date of this Act. A grant awarded before 20 that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the grant was 21 awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 23
