8	(a) In this subchapter, "structured sober living home" means a
9	program in which a person:
10	(1) provides alcohol-free or drug-free housing;
11	(2) promotes independent living and life skills
12	development; and
13	(3) provides structured activities for recovery from
14	substance abuse disorders in a supervised setting to a group of
15	unrelated individuals who are:
16	(A) recovering from alcohol or drug addiction;
17	<u>and</u>
18	(B) receiving outpatient behavioral health
19	services for substance abuse or addiction treatment while residing
20	in the program's home.
21	(b) The term "structured sober living home" does not include
22	a person who requires a related family member to receive outpatient
23	behavioral health services for substance abuse or addiction
2/	treatment as a condition of continuing to reside in the nerson's
