- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Sections 2303.155(b) and (c), Occupations Code,
- are amended to read as follows: 8
- 9 (b) The operator of a vehicle storage facility
- governmental vehicle storage facility may charge the owner of a 10
- 11 vehicle stored or parked at the facility:
- (1) a notification fee set in a reasonable amount $_{\underline{\prime}}$ 12
- subject to Subsection (c), for providing notice under this 13
- subchapter, including notice under Section 2303.154(c); 14
- (2) an impoundment fee of \$20, subject to Section 15
- 2303.1552, for any action that: 16
- is taken by or at the direction of the owner 17 (A)
- or operator of the facility; and 18
- is necessary to preserve, protect, or service 19
- a vehicle stored or parked at the facility; 20
- 21 (3) a daily storage fee, subject to Section 2303.1552,

- 23 (A) \$20 for each day or part of a day the vehicle
- is stored at the facility if the vehicle is not longer than 25 feet; 2.4

- 2 (B) \$35 for each day or part of a day the vehicle
- 3 is stored at the facility if the vehicle is longer than 25 feet; and
- 4 (4) any fee that is required to be submitted to a law
- 5 enforcement agency, the agency's authorized agent, or

- 7 (c) A notification fee under Subsection (b) may not, subject
- 8 to Section 2303.1552, exceed \$50, except that if notice by
- 9 publication is required by this chapter and the cost of publication
- 10 exceeds 50 percent of the notification fee, the vehicle storage
- 11 facility may recover the additional amount of the cost of
- 12 publication from the vehicle owner or agent.
- SECTION 2. Section 2303.1552(b), Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) Each odd-numbered year, the commission, not later than
- 16 November 1:
- 17 (1) by rule may adjust the impoundment fee under
- 18 Section $2303.155(b)(2)_{\underline{I}}$ [and] the storage fees under Section

- 3 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 2303, Occupations Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Sections 2303.1553 and 2303.1554 to read as

- 6 Sec. 2303.1553. ONE-TIME ADJUSTMENT TO CERTAIN FEES:
- 7 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) Not later than November 1, 2023, the
- 8 commission shall:
- 9 (1) adjust the impoundment fee under Section
- 10 <u>2303.155(b)(2)</u>, the storage fees under Section <u>2303.155(b)(3)</u>, and
- 11 the maximum amount of the notification fee under Section
- 12 2303.155(c) by an amount equal to the amount of the applicable fee
- or maximum amount in effect on December 31, 2005, multiplied by the
- 14 percentage increase or decrease, if any, in the consumer price
- index, as defined by Section 2303.1552(a), that occurred during the
- 16 period beginning December 31, 2005, and ending December 31, 2019;

- 18 (2) if a fee or maximum amount is adjusted under
- 19 Subdivision (1), publish the adjusted fee or maximum amount on the

- 23 MAXIMUM AMOUNT: TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) Not later than November 1,
- 24 2023, the commission shall increase the maximum amount of the
- 25 notification fee under Section 2303.155(c) by an amount equal to
- 26 the sum of:

- 11 <u>Section 2303.1552(b) on October 29, 2021, 46 Tex. Reg. 7399 (2021).</u>
- 12 (b) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
