- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 48.110(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) For each annual graduate in a cohort described by
- 8 Subsection (b) who demonstrates college, career, or military
- 9 readiness as described by Subsection (f) in excess of the minimum
- 10 number of students determined for the applicable district cohort
- 11 under Subsection (c), a school district is entitled to an annual
- 12 outcomes bonus of:
- 13 (1) if the annual graduate is educationally
- 14 disadvantaged, \$5,000;
- 15 (2) if the annual graduate is not educationally
- 16 disadvantaged, \$3,000; and
- 17 (3) if the annual graduate is enrolled in a special
- 18 education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, \$4,000 [\$2,000],
- 19 regardless of whether the annual graduate is educationally
- 20 disadvantaged.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
