A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the operation of a motor vehicle passing a person

- 3 operating a bicycle; creating a criminal offense.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 545.0571 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.0571. MOTOR VEHICLE PASSING BICYCLE OPERATOR. (a)
- 8 An operator of a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid
- 9 colliding with a person operating a bicycle on a highway or street.
- (b) For the purposes of Section 545.053(a), safe distance
- 11 from any part of a bicycle is at least three feet.
- (c) For the purposes of Section 545.057(a), conditions
- 13 permit safely passing a bicycle to the right only if the motor
- 14 vehicle passes at least three feet from any part of the bicycle.
- 15 (d) An operator of a motor vehicle passing a person
- 16 operating a bicycle on a highway or street that has two or more
- 17 marked lanes running in the same direction shall move the motor
- 18 vehicle to a lane other than the lane used by the bicycle operator
- 19 while passing the bicycle operator.
- (e) Subsections (b), (c), and (d) do not apply when the
- 21 bicycle is being operated in a designated bicycle lane.
- 22 (f) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
- 23 section that at the time of the offense the bicycle operator was
- 24 acting in violation of a traffic law in a manner that contributed to

- 1 the offense under this section.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 545.055, Transportation Code, is amended
- 3 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] operator
- 6 may not drive on the left side of the roadway in a no-passing zone or
- 7 on the left side of any pavement striping designed to mark a
- 8 no-passing zone.
- 9 <u>(b-1) Subsection (b)</u> [This subsection] does not prohibit a
- 10 driver from:
- 11 (1) crossing pavement striping, or the center line in
- 12 a no-passing zone marked by signs only, to make a left turn into or
- 13 out of an alley or private road or driveway; or
- 14 (2) passing a person operating a bicycle in a
- 15 no-passing zone if the operator of the motor vehicle otherwise
- 16 complies with the requirements of this chapter.
- 17 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 19 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 20 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 22 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 23 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
