(a) In this section<u>:</u>

(1) "Commodity[, "commodity] items" means commercial 8 9 software, hardware, or technology services, other than telecommunications services, that are generally available to 10 11 businesses or the public and for which the department determines 12 that a reasonable demand exists from <u>a customer</u> [two or more customers], including a state agency or [agencies and] political 13 subdivision [subdivisions] of this state, an entity [entities] 14 described by Subsection (j), or a [and] governmental entity 15 16 [entities] of another state, that <u>purchases</u> [purchase] the items through the department. The term includes seat management, through 17 which a customer transfers its personal computer equipment and 18 service responsibilities to a private vendor to manage the personal 19 20 computing needs for each desktop of the customer, including all 21 necessary hardware, software, and support services.

(2) "Technology services" means services, regardless
of how the fees for those services are generally charged, that:
(A) relate to the development, configuration,
