9	eligible school district or open-enrollment charter school in
10	providing salaries to peace officers, school resource officers, or
11	other security personnel performing law enforcement duties for the
12	district or school.
13	(b) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
14	be eligible for a grant under this section only if the district or
15	school employs a total of 10 or fewer security personnel.
16	(c) The agency shall adopt rules as necessary to administer
17	this section, including rules that establish:
18	(1) additional eligibility criteria for grant
19	applicants;
20	(2) grant application procedures;
21	(3) guidelines relating to grant amounts;
22	(4) procedures for evaluating grant applications; and
23	(5) procedures for monitoring the use of a grant
24	awarded under this section and ensuring compliance with any

1 conditions of a grant.

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
