4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 12.101, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b-0) and adding Subsection (b-11) to read as

(b-0) The commissioner shall notify the State Board of 8 9 Education of each charter the commissioner proposes to grant under this subchapter. Except as provided by Subsection (b-11), unless, 10 11 [Unless,] before the 90th day after the date on which the board 12 receives the notice from the commissioner, a majority of the members of the board present and voting vote against the grant of 13 14 that charter, the commissioner's proposal to grant the charter takes effect. The board may not deliberate or vote on any grant of a 15

(b-11) The commissioner shall notify the board of trustees 17 of each school district located in the geographical area expected 18 19 to be served by a proposed open-enrollment charter school under a charter the commissioner proposes to grant under this subchapter of 20 the proposed charter. Not later than the 90th day after receiving a 21 notification under this subsection, the board of trustees shall 22 23 vote on the question of whether the board approves the commissioner's proposal. The commissioner may not grant a charter 24

charter that is not proposed by the commissioner.

- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an application for a charter received by the commissioner of
- 5 education on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
