3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
5	Sections 26.0025, 26.0026, and 26.0062 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 26.0025. PARENTAL RIGHTS INFORMATION. (a) The agency
7	shall create and maintain a document that informs a parent of the
8	parent's rights regarding the education of the parent's child
9	provided under this chapter.
10	(b) The document must:
11	(1) include information regarding accessing the
12	<pre>contents of this chapter;</pre>
13	(2) be made publicly available in a prominent place on
14	the Internet website of the agency and each school district; and
15	(3) be provided to parents at the beginning of each
16	school year in an electronic or hard copy format.
17	Sec. 26.0026. RIGHT TO SELECT EDUCATIONAL SETTING. A
18	parent is entitled to choose the educational setting for the
19	parent's child, including public school, private school, or home
20	school.
21	Sec. 26.0062. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE REGARDING INSTRUCTIONAL
22	PLAN. (a) Each school district shall adopt a policy to make
23	available on the district's Internet website at the beginning of
24	each semester an instructional plan or course syllabus for each

- 2 (b) The policy adopted under Subsection (a) must:
- 3 (1) require each teacher to provide before the
- 4 beginning of each semester a copy of the teacher's instructional
- 5 plan or course syllabus for each class for which the teacher
- 6 provides instruction to:
- 7 (A) district administration; and
- 8 (B) the parent of each student enrolled in the
- 9 class;
- 10 (2) provide for additional copies of an instructional
- 11 plan or course syllabus to be made available to a parent of a
- 12 student enrolled in the class on the parent's request.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 14 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
