## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 434.00791(b), Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The commission shall ensure a system to electronically
- 9 monitor the use of tuition and fee exemptions at institutions of
- 10 higher education under Section 54.341, Education Code, is
- 11 developed. The system must allow the commission to electronically
- 12 receive, for each semester, the following information from
- 13 institutions of higher education:
- 14 (1) the name of the institution;
- 15 (2) the name, identification number, and date of birth
- 16 of each individual attending the institution and receiving benefits
- 17 for the semester under Section 54.341, Education Code;
- 18 (3) for each individual receiving benefits, the number
- 19 of credit hours for which the individual received an exemption for
- 20 the semester;
- 21 (4) for each individual receiving benefits at the
- 22 institution during the semester, the total cumulative number of
- 23 credit hours for which the individual has received an exemption at
- 24 the institution; [and]

- 1 (5) copies of any documentation required from an
- 2 individual attending the institution for the receipt of benefits
- 3 for the semester; and
- 4 (6) any other information required by the commission.
- 5 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 6 beginning with the 2023 fall semester.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
