- 5 SECTION 1. Section 157.9015, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) This subsection applies only to a county with a
- 8 population of more than one million. If a district or county
- 9 attorney declines to represent a county official or employee in a
- 10 <u>suit described by Subsection (c), the county official or employee</u>
- 11 may request representation from the attorney general, and the
- 12 attorney general may offer to represent the county official or
- 13 <u>employee</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
