5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.090 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1001.090. E-CIGARETTE AND TOBACCO USE PREVENTION AND
8	CESSATION PROGRAM. (a) Using available resources, the department
9	shall develop and implement an e-cigarette and tobacco use
10	prevention and cessation program. The program must include:
11	(1) a telephone hotline that provides counseling
12	regarding e-cigarette and tobacco cessation, using current best
13	practices; and
14	(2) information about the program and other services
15	provided by the department or the commission that are available to
16	women who are pregnant or postpartum.
17	(b) The department may enter into an agreement with a
18	nonprofit organization to implement this section.
19	(c) The department shall accept all eligible applicants for
20	the program described by Subsection (a) who are pregnant or gave
21	birth in the preceding year. The department shall prioritize
22	providing program services to these applicants. This shall include
23	providing the counseling described in Subsection (a)(1) in the
24	amount and duration consistent with current best practices, to the
