## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the establishment and operation of veterans cemeteries.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 164.005, Natural Resources Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsections (f) and (h) and adding Subsection
- 6 (i) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The board, the chairman of the Texas Veterans
- 8 Commission, and two representatives of the veterans community
- 9 selected by the chairman of the Texas Veterans Commission shall:
- 10 (1) establish the guidelines for determining:
- 11 (A) the location and size of veterans cemeteries;
- 12 and
- 13 (B) the eligibility for burial in a veterans
- 14 cemetery; and
- 15 (2) select up to seven locations across the state for
- 16 veterans cemeteries one of which must be in a county that is
- 17 contiguous to an international border and the Gulf of Mexico.
- 18 (h) Of the funds available in the veterans' land fund, the
- 19 veterans' housing assistance fund, and the veterans' housing
- 20 assistance fund II that may be used for veterans cemeteries, the
- 21 board may spend not more than \$10[7] million each fiscal year to
- 22 plan and design, operate, maintain, enlarge, or improve veterans
- 23 cemeteries. The board may not use funds from the veterans' land
- 24 fund, the veterans' housing assistance fund, or the veterans'

- 1 housing assistance fund II to acquire land to be used for a veterans
- 2 cemetery.
- 3 (i) In addition to using funds described by Subsection (h),
- 4 the board may plan and design, operate, maintain, enlarge, or
- 5 <u>improve veterans cemeteries using funds available or appropriated</u>
- 6 to the board for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
