2	relating to establishing a program to allow certain child-care
3	providers to provide free or reduced-cost breakfast and lunch

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 302.00437 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 302.00437. EARLY CHILDHOOD BREAKFAST AND LUNCH GRANT
9	PROGRAM. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Child-care provider" means a day-care center or a
11	group day-care home licensed under Chapter 42, Human Resources
12	Code, or a family home registered under Chapter 42, Human Resources
13	Code.
14	(2) "Eligible child" means a child who:
15	(A) is eligible for services from a federal Head
16	Start or Early Head Start program;
17	(B) receives subsidized child-care services; or
18	(C) except for the child's age, meets a
19	requirement of Section 29.153(b), Education Code.
20	(3) "Eligible meal" means a breakfast or lunch that
21	meets the nutritional requirements for:
22	(A) the national school breakfast program as
23	provided by the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section
24	<u>1773); or</u>

- 1 (B) the national school lunch program of free or
- 2 reduced-price lunches under 7 C.F.R. Section 210.10 or a successor
- 3 regulation.
- 4 (4) "Program" means the early childhood breakfast and
- 5 lunch grant program established under this section.
- 6 (b) The commission shall establish the early childhood
- 7 breakfast and lunch grant program to award grants to child-care
- 8 providers to provide eligible meals to eligible children for free
- 9 or at a reduced cost.
- 10 (c) A child-care provider may elect to participate in the
- 11 program. A child-care provider participating in the program shall
- 12 offer eligible meals without charge or at a reduced cost to each
- 13 eligible enrolled child.
- 14 (d) From funds appropriated for the purpose, the commission
- 15 shall provide grants to reimburse child-care providers that
- 16 participate in the program for costs related to providing meals
- 17 under Subsection (c) in an amount established by the commission
- 18 that ensures each participating child-care provider is able to
- 19 receive a grant.
- 20 (e) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this
- 21 section, including rules regarding the eligibility criteria for
- 22 receiving a grant and the process for awarding a grant under this
- 23 <u>section.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
