- 8 Sec. 54.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "alternatives to
 9 abortion program" means the program established by the commission
 10 to enhance and increase resources that promote childbirth for women
 11 facing unplanned pregnancy.
- Sec. 54.002. PATIENT NAVIGATOR SERVICES FOR CERTAIN

 EXPECTANT PARENTS. (a) The alternatives to abortion program must
- 14 provide access to a third-party patient navigator for expectant
- 15 mothers and fathers who receive a prenatal diagnosis for their
- 16 unborn child of a significant fetal anomaly, rare disorder, or
- 17 other chronic, medically complex disability or condition.
- 18 <u>(b) A third-party patient navigator who provides services</u> 19 under the alternatives to abortion program shall:
- 20 <u>(1) connect expectant parents with support and</u>
- 21 advocacy groups specific to the fetal diagnosis for their child;
- 22 and

- (2) assist expectant parents with applying for home-
- 24 and community-based medical care, support, and services for their

- 2 Sec. 54.003. NURSING FACILITY DIVERSION. (a) The
- 3 <u>alternatives to abortion program must provide nursing facility</u>
- 4 diversion space to allow immediate access to the medically
- 5 dependent children (MDCP) waiver program for children born with a
- 6 rare disorder or other chronic, medically complex disability or
- 7 condition.
- 8 (b) An expectant mother or father may apply for access to a
- 9 nursing facility diversion space described by Subsection (a) before
- 10 or after the child's birth.
- Sec. 54.004. RULES. The executive commissioner shall adopt
- 12 rules as necessary to implement this chapter.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
