H.B. No. 4848

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to receive
3 certain tax revenue derived from a hotel and convention center
4 project and to pledge certain tax revenue for the payment of
5 obligations related to the project.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Sections 351.157 (b) and (c), Tax Code, are
8 amended to read as follows:

3 (c) A municipality is entitled to receive revenue under
4 Subsection (d) derived from the following types of establishments
5 that meet the requirements of Subsections (a)(1), (2), (3), and
6 (4):

7 (1) for a municipality described by Subsection (b)(1):

8 (A) restaurants, bars, and retail
9 establishments; and

10 (B) swimming pools and swimming facilities owned
11 or operated by the related qualified hotel;

12 (2) for a municipality described by Subsection (b)(2),
13 swimming pools and swimming facilities, restaurants, bars, and
14 retail establishments;

15 (3) for a municipality described by Subsection (b)(3),
16 restaurants, bars, and retail establishments;

17 (4) for a municipality described by Subsection (b)(4):

18 (A) restaurants, bars, and retail
19 establishments; and

20 (B) swimming pools and swimming facilities owned
21 or operated by the related qualified hotel;

22 (4-a) for a municipality described by Subsection
23 (b)(4- a):

24 (A) restaurants, bars, and retail
25 establishments; and

26 (B) swimming pools and swimming facilities owned
27 or operated by the related qualified hotel;

1 (5) for a municipality described by Subsection (b)(5),
2 restaurants, bars, and retail establishments;

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
