- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 32.03117 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.03117. REIMBURSEMENT FOR NON-OPIOID TREATMENTS.
- 8 (a) In this section, "non-opioid treatment" means a drug or
- 9 biological product that is indicated to produce analgesia without
- 10 acting on the body's opioid receptors.
- 11 (b) The commission shall ensure that medical assistance
- 12 reimbursement is provided to a provider who provides a non-opioid
- 13 treatment to a recipient under the medical assistance program.
- 14 (c) The executive commissioner by rule shall ensure that, to
- 15 the extent permitted by federal law, a hospital provider that
- 16 provides outpatient department services to a medical assistance
- 17 recipient is reimbursed separately under the medical assistance
- 18 program for any non-opioid treatment provided as a part of those
- 19 <u>services.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 21 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 22 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 23 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 24 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
