- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 122.301, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) A state agency may [not] authorize a person to
- 9 manufacture a product containing hemp for smoking.
- 10 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), "Smoking" means burning
- 11 or igniting a substance and inhaling the smoke or heating a
- 12 substance and inhaling the resulting vapor or aerosol.
- SECTION 2. Section 443.204, Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 amended by amending Subsections (2) and (3) to read as follows:
- 15 (2) products containing one or more hemp-derived
- 16 cannabinoids, such as cannabidiol, intended for ingestion are
- 17 considered foods, not controlled substances or adulterated
- 18 products; and
- 19 (3) consumable hemp products must be packaged and
- 20 labeled in the manner provided by Section 443.205. [; and]
- 21 SECTION 3. Sections 443.001(11) and 443.204(4), Health and
- 22 Safety Code, are repealed:
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
