H.B. No. 4952

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the security of the electricity supply chain. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter F, Chapter 4 38, 5 Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER F. [TEXAS] ELECTRICITY SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY AND MAPPING 6 7 [COMMITTEE] SECTION 2. Section 38.201(c), Utilities Code, is amended to 8 9 read as follows: (c) The committee is composed of: 10 11 (1)the executive director of the commission; 12 (2) the executive director of the Railroad Commission of Texas; 13 14 (3) the president and the chief executive officer of the independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the 15 ERCOT power region; [and] 16 the public safety director of the Department of 17 (4) Public Safety; and 18 (5) the chief of the Texas Division of Emergency 19 20 Management. 21 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is 22 amended by adding Section 38.205 to read as follows: 23 Sec. 38.205. PHYSICAL SECURITY OF SUBSTATIONS. (a) The commission shall require each electric cooperative, municipally 24

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owned utility, and transmission and distribution utility to include 1 in the cooperative's or utility's emergency operations plan 2 described by Section 186.007 information about the physical 3 security of the cooperative's or utility's critical substations and 4 contact information for each law enforcement agency with 5 6 jurisdiction over the critical substations. 7 (b) The commission shall provide the Department of Public 8 Safety with access to the information described by Subsection (a). (c) Information provided to the commission or the 9 Department of Public Safety under this section is confidential 10 under Section 418.181, Government Code, and not subject to 11 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code. 12

13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
