 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the sale, possession, or consumption of alcoholic
 1-21 beverages at the Texas State History Museum.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 445.003, Government Code, is amended by
 1-24 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-25 (c) The museum may provide for the public sale, possession,
 1-26 or consumption of alcoholic beverages on property owned or
 1-27 controlled by the museum.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
