1-22 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-23 AN ACT

1-24 relating to a campus of the Texas State Technical College System
 1-25 located in Comal County and Guadalupe County.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 135.02(a), Education Code, is amended to
 1-28 read as follows:

1-29 (a) The Texas State Technical College System is composed of:

1-30 (1) a system office located in the city of Waco in
 1-31 McLennan County;

1-32 (2) a campus located in the city of Harlingen in
 1-33 Cameron County;

1-34 (3) a campus serving West Texas that operates as a
 1-35 collective unit of strategically positioned permanent locations in
 1-36 the city of Sweetwater in Nolan County, the city of Abilene in
 1-37 Taylor County, the city of Brownwood in Brown County, and the city
 1-38 of Breckenridge in Stephens County;

1-39 (4) a campus located in the city of Marshall in
 1-40 Harrison County;

1-41 (5) a campus located in the city of Waco in McLennan
 1-42 County;

1-43 (6) a campus located in Fort Bend County;

1-44 (7) a campus located in the city of Red Oak in Ellis
 1-45 County; ~~and~~

1-46 (8) a campus that operates as a collective unit of one
 1-47 or more locations in Comal County and Guadalupe County; and

1-48 (9) campuses assigned to the system from time to time
 1-49 by specific legislative Act.

1-50 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-51 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-52 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-53 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-54 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
