5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 531.0185 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 531.0185. SUBCONTRACTOR INFORMATION CLAUSE. (a) The
9	commission shall include in each contract the commission enters
10	into a clause that requires any contractor to disclose the
11	following information relating to any subcontractor under the
12	<pre>contract:</pre>
13	(1) the process the contractor uses to select
14	subcontractors;
15	(2) the number of persons who submit subcontractor
16	proposals to the contractor and the name of each person who:
17	(A) submits a proposal to be a subcontractor; and
18	(B) is awarded a subcontract under the contract;
19	<u>and</u>
20	(3) the reasons for the contractor's selection of one
21	subcontractor over another subcontractor.
22	(b) Not later than September 1 of each year, the commission
23	shall submit a report to the legislature and the presiding officer
24	of each legislative standing committee with jurisdiction over the

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- 1 commission that includes a summary of the information collected
- 2 from reports submitted under this section.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 531.0185, Government Code, as added by
- 4 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
- 5 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
- 6 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 7 date the contract was entered into, and the former law is continued
- 8 in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
