- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.018, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) Any person other than a person described by Subsection
- 8 (a) may file in a district court of Travis County, or in the county
- 9 in which the property is located, a suit to obtain either a
- 10 temporary or permanent court order or injunction, either
- 11 prohibitory or mandatory, to remove or prevent any improvement,
- 12 maintenance, obstruction, barrier, or other encroachment on a
- 13 public beach, or to prohibit any unlawful restraint on the public's
- 14 right of access to and use of a public beach or other activity that
- 15 violates this chapter. This subsection does not authorize a suit to
- 16 remove a house described by Subsection (a-1). In an action brought
- 17 under this subsection, the court may award a prevailing claimant
- 18 reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in bringing the
- 19 <u>action.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 61.0185(g), Natural Resources Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (g) A county attorney, district attorney, [oriminal
- 23 district attorney, or other person may not file suit under Section
- 24 61.018 [61.018(a)] to obtain a temporary or permanent court order

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- 1 or injunction, either prohibitory or mandatory, to remove a house
- 2 from a public beach while the house is subject to an order issued
- 3 under this section.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
