Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 442.00515 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 442.00515. FEE WAIVER. (a) The executive director shall waive the entrance fee for a historic site under the 10 commission's jurisdiction for an individual who is eligible to 11 receive a gold star lapel button pursuant to 10 U.S.C. Section 1126. 12 (b) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement 13 14 a fee waiver under this section. SECTION 2. Sections 13.018(a) and (c), Parks and Wildlife 15 Code, are amended to read as follows: 16 17 (a) The following people may apply to the department for a state parklands passport: 18 (1) a resident of this state who is 65 years old or 19 over who has resided in the state for six consecutive months 20 preceding the date of application for a parklands passport, a 21 member of the United States armed forces on active duty who is 65 22 23 years old or over, or any other individual in a category that the commission by rule designates as a resident of this state who is 65 24

1 years old or over;

(2) a veteran of the armed services of the United 2 3 States who, as а result of military service, has а service-connected disability, defined by the Veterans' 4 as 5 Administration, consisting of the loss of the use of a lower extremity or of a 60 percent disability rating and who is receiving 6 7 compensation from the United States because of the disability; 8 [and]

9 (3) an individual who has a physical or mental 10 impairment that substantially limits one or more of the major life 11 activities of the individual<u>; and</u>

12 (4) an individual who is eligible to receive a gold
13 star lapel button pursuant to 10 U.S.C. Section 1126.

14 (c) The holder of a state parklands passport issued on or 15 before August 31, 1995, a person whose birth date is before September 1, 1930, or a person [veteran] described by Subsection 16 17 (a)(2) or (a)(4) is entitled to enter any state park without payment of an entrance or admission fee. When a fee is charged by the 18 department for entrance of a vehicle into a state park, the vehicle 19 of the holder of a state parklands passport is exempt from the fee 20 when the holder is present. 21
