## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study and report by the Texas Higher Education 3 Coordinating Board regarding a teacher apprenticeship program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 61.06692 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 61.06692. STUDY AND REPORT ON TEACHER APPRENTICESHIP
- 8 PROGRAM. (a) The board, with the assistance of the Texas Education
- 9 Agency and the State Board for Educator Certification, shall
- 10 conduct a study to determine the feasibility of and best practices
- 11 for allowing students to obtain certification as a classroom
- 12 teacher under an apprenticeship program.
- 13 (b) The study must provide for an alternate pathway for
- 14 teacher certification that takes less time to complete, is more
- 15 affordable, and involves more direct experience than the standard
- 16 pathway for teacher certification.
- 17 <u>(c) In conducting the study, the board shall collaborate</u>
- 18 with the Texas Education Agency and the State Board for Educator
- 19 <u>Certification</u>.

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- 20 (d) Not later than December 1, 2025, the board shall submit
- 21 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
- 22 of representatives, the commissioner of education, and the State
- 23 Board for Educator Certification a written report that includes the
- 24 study's findings and any recommendations for legislative or other

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- 1 action.
- 2 (e) This section expires January 1, 2026.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
