6	Sec. 411.404. RADIO INTEROPERABILITY IN COUNTIES AFFECTED
7	BY OPERATION LONE STAR. In any county impacted by or adjacent to
8	Operation Lone Star, the department shall ensure that all public
9	safety entities have emergency radio infrastructure that allows
10	inter operable communication between all other public safety
11	entities, including communication between different types of
12	public safety agencies.
13	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
14	amended by adding Section 411.2098 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 411.2098. MASS SHOOTING TRAINING. The department
16	shall establish a process to train public safety entities including
17	local law enforcement entities in response to a mass shooting
18	event. The training must include the following:
19	(1) protection of students in a mass shooting event at
20	a school;
21	(2) emergency medical response training in minimizing
22	gun violence casualties;
23	(3) tactics for denying an intruder entry into a

24 classroom or school facility; and

- 2 shooting event.
- 3 SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
