## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation of certain contract carriers and 3 subcontractors of contract carriers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 644.054, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 7 read as follows:

8 (a) <u>In this section</u>, "contract carrier" includes a
9 <u>subcontractor of a contract carrier</u>.

10 <u>(a-1)</u> This section applies only to a contract carrier that 11 transports an operating employee of a railroad on a road or highway 12 of this state in a vehicle designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers.

13 (b) The department shall adopt rules regulating the 14 operation of a contract carrier to which this section applies. The 15 rules must:

16 (1) prohibit a person from operating a vehicle for 17 more than 12 hours in a day;

18 (2) require a person who operates a vehicle for the
19 number of consecutive hours or days the department determines is
20 excessive to rest for a period determined by the department;

(3) require a contract carrier to keep a record of all hours a vehicle subject to regulation under this section is operated;

1 drug testing of vehicle operators on employment, on suspicion of 2 alcohol or drug abuse, and periodically as determined by the 3 department;

4 (5) require a contract carrier, at a minimum, to
5 maintain <u>commercial automobile</u> liability insurance in the amount of
6 <u>\$3</u> [<del>\$1.5</del>] million for each vehicle; and

7 (6) be determined by the department to be necessary to
8 protect the safety of a passenger being transported or the general
9 public.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
