17	(3) a debit made through a financial institution debit
18	card.
19	(c) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
20	or knowingly sells ammunition for a firearm to a person who is
21	younger than 18 years of age.
22	(d) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
23	or knowingly sells ammunition for a firearm to a person without
24	verifying the age of the purchaser by examining a driver's license

- 4 (e) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
