- SECTION 2. Section 16.006(b), Agriculture Code, as amended
- 15 by Chapters 1295 (H.B. 2318) and 1312 (H.B. 2582), Acts of the 81st
- 16 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted to read as

- 18 (b) A producer is entitled to receive from the account 20
- 19 cents for each gallon of fuel ethanol, renewable diesel, or MMBtu of
