## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the powers of the Hidalgo County Drainage District

3 Number 1.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Hidalgo County Drainage District Number 1 is an existing conservation and reclamation district, and body politic, 6 operating pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas 7 Constitution, exercising the rights, powers, privileges and 8 authority granted a drainage district by Chapter 56, Water Code, 9 and all other laws of the State of Texas relating to drainage 10 11 districts, (all such laws being hereinafter referred to as "General 12 Laws"). All such General Laws are hereby incorporated by this reference to the same effect as if set out in full in this Act. To 13 14 the extent that the provisions of any such General Laws may be in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, the 15 provisions of this Act shall prevail. Without limitation of the 16 generality of the foregoing the District shall be and it is hereby 17 empowered to control, conserve, protect, distribute and utilize the 18 storm and flood waters and unappropriated flow of waters within its 19 20 boundaries for all useful purposes permitted by law; also to carry 21 out flood prevention measures to prevent or aid in preventing 22 damage to the lands of the District and the soil and fertility thereof, to cooperate with all other districts, departments or 23 agencies of the state government, or departments and agencies of 24

- 1 the United States government, and to receive and accept technical
- 2 and financial assistance therefrom in the accomplishment of said
- 3 purposes. The said District is further authorized and empowered to
- 4 purchase, construct, or in any other lawful manner to acquire,
- 5 provide and develop all works, facilities and improvements
- 6 necessary or useful in fulfilling the purposes of the District or
- 7 any of them.
- 8 SECTION 2. The boundaries of the Hidalgo County Drainage
- 9 District Number 1 are coterminous with Hidalgo County, Texas.
- 10 SECTION 3. In addition to the rights, powers, privileges
- 11 and authority exercised by the Hidalgo County Drainage District
- 12 Number 1, pursuant to the General Laws, the District is hereby
- 13 authorized to exercise the powers granted and shall exercise the
- 14 duties of a water improvement district imposed under Chapter 55,
- 15 Water Code, for the preservation, conservation, protection,
- 16 recharge, and prevention of waste and pollution of the waters and
- 17 natural resources of the state, including for irrigation of the
- 18 land within its boundaries and the treatment and delivery of water
- 19 for domestic, power, and commercial purposes.
- 20 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 21 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 22 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 23 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 24 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 25 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 26 Government Code.
- 27 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has

- 1 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 2 Environmental Quality.
- 3 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 4 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 5 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 6 representatives within the required time.
- 7 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 8 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 9 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 10 and accomplished.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2023, , except as otherwise provided
- 16 by this Act.
