7 to Brock, where they lived for a few years before settling in  
8 Weatherford; a graduate of Weatherford College, she embarked on a  
9 career in land title insurance in 1974 and continued working in the  
10 industry for many years while raising her son, Brandon, as a single  
11 mother; and

12           WHEREAS, In 2011, she married Jimmy Martin, and together they  
13 created a blended family that included her stepchildren, Tracie,  
14 Tory, and Annabeth; a doting grandmother, Mrs. Martin treasured  
15 spending time with her 11 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren;

18 leadership roles with the Parker County Committee on Aging, the  
19 Weatherford Chamber of Commerce, and the Weatherford Independent  
20 School District Education Foundation, and she served on the Park

23 Foundation and was involved with the Weatherford Lions Club and  
24 Meals on Wheels; sustained by a deep and abiding faith, she was a
