1 WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to 2 a close with the passing of Fire Chief Curtis Dewayne Brown of the Dalhart Fire Department on October 4, 2022, at the age of 51; and 3 WHEREAS, The son of Richard Brown and Linda Miller, Curtis 4 5 Brown was born in Dalhart on July 12, 1971; he grew up in Haven, Kansas, with the companionship of two siblings, Paul and Billy, and 6 7 he graduated from Haven High School in 1989; and WHEREAS, After returning to Texas, Mr. Brown joined the 8 9 Dalhart Fire Department, and he was promoted to captain in his first year; he was later named fire chief, and over the course of his 10 11 nearly three decades with the agency, he earned certification as a 12 master firefighter and emergency care attendant; he also served as the City of Dalhart Fire Marshal for 17 years, and he was an 13 14 instructor at the world's largest live fire training facility, TEEX Brayton Fire Training Field, for 10 years; he further distinguished 15 16 himself as a member of Hartley Fire and EMS; among his many honors, he was named the 2016 Firefighter of the Year by the Panhandle 17 Firefighters' and Fire Marshals' Association and the State 18 Firefighters' and Fire Marshals' Association of Texas; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Dedicated to his profession, Mr. Brown held 21 leadership positions with both the Panhandle State Firefighters' and Fire Marshals' Associations; he 22 further 23 contributed to his community through his service with the Rotary Club, the Coffee Memorial Blood Center board, and the Brother's 24

- 12 leaves behind a record of service that his loved ones can remember
