7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by 9 adding Section 1-u to read as follows:

10 <u>Sec. 1-u. The legislature by general law may authorize the</u> 11 <u>commissioners court of a county to exempt from ad valorem taxation</u> 12 <u>by each political subdivision that taxes the property the portion</u> 13 <u>of the assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to</u> 14 <u>the installation in or on the property of a rainwater harvesting or</u> 15 <u>graywater system and may provide additional eligibility</u> 16 <u>requirements for the exemption.</u>

17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023. 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the 20 21 commissioners court of a county to exempt from ad valorem taxation by each political subdivision that taxes the property the portion 22 23 of the assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to the installation in or on the property of a rainwater harvesting or 24
