A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the denial of bail
- 2 to certain persons arrested for an offense resulting in the death of
- 3 or serious bodily injury to a person younger than 18 years of age.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 11d to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11d. (a) A person taken into custody for an offense
- 8 resulting in the death of or serious bodily injury to a person
- 9 younger than 18 years of age shall be denied release on bail pending
- 10 trial for a period not to exceed 30 days if a judge or magistrate,
- 11 following a hearing, determines:
- 12 (1) by a preponderance of the evidence that the person
- 13 engaged in the conduct constituting the offense; and
- 14 (2) by clear and convincing evidence that requiring
- 15 bail and conditions of release is insufficient to reasonably
- 16 ensure:
- 17 (A) the person's appearance in court as required;
- 18 <u>or</u>
- 19 (B) the safety of the community, law enforcement,
- 20 or the victim of the alleged offense.
- 21 (b) A person may not be denied bail under this section more
- 22 than once with respect to the same offense.
- 23 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 24 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
