A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment creating the broadband
- 2 infrastructure fund to assist in the financing of broadband and
- 3 telecommunications services projects in the state.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 49-d-16 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 49-d-16. (a) In this section:
- 8 (1) "Commission" means the Public Utility Commission
- 9 of Texas or its successor.
- 10 (2) "Comptroller" means the comptroller of public
- 11 accounts of the State of Texas or its successor.
- 12 (3) "Fund" means the broadband infrastructure fund.
- 13 (b) The broadband infrastructure fund is created as a
- 14 special fund in the state treasury outside the general revenue
- 15 fund.
- 16 (c) As provided by general law, the fund shall be
- 17 administered by the comptroller to provide a method of financing
- 18 projects for the development of broadband and telecommunications
- 19 services, including the construction, reconstruction, and
- 20 expansion of broadband and telecommunications infrastructure or
- 21 services, the operation of broadband and telecommunications
- 22 infrastructure, and the provision of broadband and
- 23 telecommunications services, as determined by the comptroller and
- 24 the commission.

- 1 (d) Money in the fund is dedicated by this constitution for
- 2 purposes of Section 22, Article VIII, of this constitution, and an
- 3 appropriation from the economic stabilization fund to the credit of
- 4 the fund is an appropriation of state tax revenues dedicated by this
- 5 constitution for the purposes of Section 22, Article VIII, of this
- 6 constitution.
- 7 (e) Money deposited to the credit to the fund and
- 8 appropriations made from the fund may be used only in accordance
- 9 with this section and general laws enacted to implement this
- 10 section. Money in the fund may be used in conjunction with other
- 11 funds or financial resources, including money from the federal
- 12 government, in accordance with procedures, standards, and
- 13 <u>limitations established by federal law and general law of this</u>
- 14 state.
- 15 <u>(f) The total amount appropriated by the legislature to the</u>
- 16 fund may not exceed \$5 billion.
- 17 (g) Unless extended by adoption of a concurrent resolution
- 18 approved by a record vote of two-thirds of the members of each house
- 19 of the legislature, this section expires on September 1, 2035. A
- 20 resolution suspends the expiration of this section until September
- 21 <u>1 of the 10th year following the adoption of the resolution.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 23 the Texas Constitution:
- TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 25 to the amendment to Article III of this constitution as proposed by
- 26 the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, creating the broadband
- 27 infrastructure fund to assist in the financing of broadband and

- 1 <u>telecommunications services projects in the state.</u>
- 2 (b) The change made to Article III of this constitution by
- 3 the amendment described in Subsection (a) takes effect January 1,
- 4 2024.
- 5 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2025.
- 6 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment creating the broadband
- 10 infrastructure fund to assist in the financing of broadband and
- 11 telecommunications services projects in the state."
