A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment protecting the right to engage
- 2 in farming, ranching, timber production, and wildlife management.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 36 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 36. (a) The people have the right to engage in
- 7 generally accepted farm, ranch, timber production, or wildlife
- 8 management practices on real property they own or lease.
- 9 (b) This section does not affect the authority of the
- 10 <u>legislature to authorize by general law:</u>
- 11 (1) a state agency or political subdivision to
- 12 regulate where there is clear and convincing evidence that the law
- 13 or regulation is necessary to protect the public health and safety
- 14 from imminent danger; or
- 15 (2) a state agency to regulate to prevent a danger to
- 16 animal health or crop production.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment protecting the right to
- 21 engage in farming, ranching, timber production, and wildlife
- 22 management."
