## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part
- 3 of the market value of the residence homestead of the surviving
- 4 spouse of a military service member who is killed or fatally injured
- 5 in the line of duty.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Sections 1-b(m) and (n), Article VIII, Texas
- 8 Constitution, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 (m) The legislature by general law may provide that the
- 10 surviving spouse of a <u>military service</u> member [<del>of the armed</del>
- 11 services of the United States] who is killed or fatally injured in
- 12 the line of duty is entitled to an exemption from ad valorem
- 13 taxation of all or part of the market value of the surviving
- 14 spouse's residence homestead if the surviving spouse has not
- 15 remarried since the death of the member of the armed services. The
- 16 <u>legislature by general</u> law may define "military service member" for
- 17 purposes of this subsection and may prescribe additional
- 18 eligibility requirements for the exemption authorized by this
- 19 <u>subsection</u>.
- 20 (n) The legislature by general law may provide that a
- 21 surviving spouse who qualifies for and receives an exemption in
- 22 accordance with Subsection (m) of this section and who subsequently
- 23 qualifies a different property as the surviving spouse's residence
- 24 homestead is entitled to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of

- 1 the subsequently qualified homestead in an amount equal to the
- 2 dollar amount of the exemption from ad valorem taxation of the first
- 3 homestead for which the exemption was received in accordance with
- 4 Subsection (m) of this section in the last year in which the
- 5 surviving spouse received the exemption in accordance with that
- 6 subsection for that homestead if the surviving spouse has not
- 7 remarried since the death of the military service member [of the
- 8 armed services].
- 9 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 10 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 11 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 12 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 13 legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of
- 14 all or part of the market value of the residence homestead of the
- 15 surviving spouse of a military service member who is killed or
- 16 fatally injured in the line of duty."
