A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment recognizing the right of a

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 36 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 36. (a) A person has the right to purchase, to own, and
- 8 to operate a motor vehicle that is powered by an
- 9 <u>internal-combustion engine</u>, subject to:
- 10 (1) laws or regulations relating to:
- (A) who is authorized to operate a vehicle, a
- 12 type of vehicle, or a class of vehicles; or
- 13 (B) the mental or physical competency required to
- 14 operate a vehicle;
- 15 (2) laws or regulations that impose or are subject to a
- 16 criminal penalty; and
- 17 (3) restrictions on the use of a vehicle resulting
- 18 from the commission of a criminal offense or other violation of a
- 19 <u>law or regulation</u>.
- 20 (b) A law or regulation may not be enacted or adopted for the
- 21 purpose of abridging the right granted by this section. A law or
- 22 regulation enacted or adopted in violation of this subsection is
- 23 void and unenforceable.
- 24 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 2 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 3 proposition: "The constitutional amendment recognizing the right
- 4 of a person to purchase, to own, and to operate a motor vehicle that
