A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the legislature to
- 2 increase the basic allotment under the Foundation School Program
- 3 and to adjust the allotment in a manner that reflects annual
- 4 inflation.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 3A. THE BASIC ALLOTMENT. For the Fiscal Year of 2025,
- 9 <u>a school district is entitled to a basic allotment equal to \$7,500</u>
- 10 for each student in addition to any higher amount per student as
- 11 provided by the Legislature. For all subsequent state fiscal
- 12 years, the Legislature shall set the basic allotment under the
- 13 Foundation School Program at the amount that results from applying
- 14 the inflation rate, as determined by the comptroller on the basis of
- 15 changes in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers published
- 16 by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of
- 17 Labor, to the allotment for the preceding school year, except that
- 18 the basic allotment may not be set at an amount that is less than the
- 19 amount of the basic allotment established by this provision. The
- 20 comptroller shall, not later than the 90th day of each fiscal year,
- 21 transfer to the Foundation School Fund 25 percent of any
- 22 unencumbered positive balance of general revenues on the last day
- 23 of the preceding fiscal year.
- 24 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 2 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 3 proposition: "The constitutional amendment setting the amount of
- 4 the basic allotment under the Foundation School Program and
- 5 providing for its adjustment for annual inflation."
