- 20 Representative Charlie Geren; additionally, she was a member of the
- 21 Northwest Tarrant, Saginaw Area, and Texas Tri-County Chambers of
- 22 Commerce; moreover, she worked to ensure the placement of smoke
- 23 alarms in area homes, earning her recognition as the Civilian Fire
- 24 Fighter of the Year; and
