18 WHEREAS, After retiring from education, Mrs. Cozart continued to serve the community as the district director for State 19 20 Representative Charlie Geren; additionally, she was a member of the 21 Northwest Tarrant, Saginaw Area, and Texas Tri-County Chambers of Commerce; moreover, she worked to ensure the placement of smoke 22 23 alarms in area homes, earning her recognition as the Civilian Fire Fighter of the Year; and 24
