1 WHEREAS, Muleshoe High School has been named a 2022 National
2 Blue Ribbon School, one of the most prestigious designations an
3 elementary or secondary school in the United States can receive;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, The National Blue Ribbon Schools Program was created
6 by the U.S. Department of Education in 1982 to recognize campuses
7 that have demonstrated superior academic performance or made
8 notable progress in improving outcomes among economically
9 disadvantaged students; Muleshoe High School was one of only 297
10 public and private schools nationwide and 31 schools in Texas to
11 have earned this impressive honor in 2022; and

12 WHEREAS, Under the able leadership of principal Cindy
13 Bessire, Muleshoe High School was selected for its exemplary work
14 in closing achievement gaps; the school has shown particular
15 progress in the math and English departments, and it also received
16 an A rating from the Texas Education Agency; the campus is part of
17 the Muleshoe Independent School District and serves approximately
18 370 students in 9th through 12th grade; and

19 WHEREAS, Through hard work and perseverance, the teachers and
20 students of Muleshoe High School have established a record of
21 scholastic excellence, and their outstanding efforts have been duly
22 recognized with the Blue Ribbon School award; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
24 Legislature hereby congratulate Muleshoe High School on its
