RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Proud members of the Justices of the Peace and 2 Constables Association of Texas are gathering in Austin on 3 February 7, 2023, for Justices of the Peace and Constables Day at 4 the State Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, The office of justice of the peace, first established in 1362 by King Edward of England, and the office of 6 7 constable, first established in 1215 by King John of England, were two of the first offices established in the American colonies in 8 9 1620; both offices were created by the Texas Constitution approximately two centuries later and continue to serve a vital 10 role in the system of county government; and 11

WHEREAS, Justices of the peace are an integral part of the Texas judiciary; they exercise jurisdiction in criminal misdemeanor cases punishable by fine or sanctions and exercise civil jurisdiction in matters in controversy up to \$20,000; justices of the peace preside over those courts closest to the people; and

18 WHEREAS, Constables serve as officers of the court as 19 bailiffs, execute civil and criminal process issued by Texas 20 courts, and enforce criminal laws as certified peace officers; the 21 first known constable to serve in Texas was appointed in 1823; and

22 WHEREAS, The men and women who accept the responsibilities of 23 the offices of justice of the peace and constable perform their 24 official duties with integrity, dedication, and the required

1 knowledge of the law, thereby contributing immeasurably to the 2 justice system, the safety of the citizens of Texas, and the peace 3 and order of our society; and
