5 is the first predominantly Nepalese Lions Club chapter in the

10 addition, DELC has helped to establish a number of other Lions Club
11 chapters in the Dallas area and beyond; and

13 activities benefiting their community, including holding regular
14 health fairs to screen for diabetes, hypertension, and obesity,
15 environmental cleanup projects, food drives, cultural events, and
16 youth tutoring programs; moreover, the group provides free
17 eyeglasses to school children and needy adults as well as
18 scholarships and disaster assistance around the world; and

22 example of civic engagement; now, therefore, be it
