RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The observance of Women's History Month in March
- 2 2023 provides an opportunity to celebrate the enormous
- 3 contributions women have made to our society; and
- WHEREAS, In 1978, the event began as a weeklong program in
- 5 Santa Rosa, California, sponsored by the Education Task Force of
- 6 the Sonoma County Commission on the Status of Women; the organizers
- 7 selected the week of March 8 to correspond with International
- 8 Women's Day; activities included an essay contest, presentations at
- 9 dozens of schools, and a downtown parade; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Other communities across the country were inspired
- 11 to launch their own Women's History Week celebrations the following
- 12 year; in 1980, the National Women's History Alliance led a
- 13 consortium of women's groups and historians in advocating for
- 14 national recognition, and that February, President Jimmy Carter
- 15 issued a proclamation declaring the week of March 8 to be National
- 16 Women's History Week; and
- WHEREAS, In 1987, at the behest of the National Women's
- 18 History Alliance, Congress expanded the observance to the entire
- 19 month; the alliance selects the theme each year, and for 2023, it
- 20 has chosen "Celebrating Women Who Tell Our Stories" to honor those
- 21 "who have devoted their lives and talents to producing art,
- 22 pursuing truth, and reflecting the human condition decade after
- 23 decade"; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Many historians in Texas have dedicated their

- 1 efforts to discovering and recognizing the legacy of women in the
- 2 Lone Star State and exploring what it means to be a Texas woman; in
- 3 1991 Governor Ann Richards supported this endeavor by issuing the
- 4 first gubernatorial proclamation in the state's history to declare
- 5 March Women's History Month; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Women have played a vital role in the development of
- 7 Texas and the United States, and National Women's History Month
- 8 provides an opportunity to acknowledge achievements that have too
- 9 often gone unsung; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 11 Legislature hereby recognize March 2023 as National Women's History
- 12 Month.
