1           WHEREAS, All who shared in the life of Kristen Michelle  
2 Bryant were deeply saddened by her passing on March 16, 2022, at the  
3 age of 38; and

4           WHEREAS, Michelle Bryant was born to Kevin and Cristi Bryant  
5 in Stillwater, Oklahoma, on June 14, 1983, and at the age of seven,  
6 she moved to Texas with her parents; as a youth, she accompanied her  
7 family on medical mission trips to Central America, and she later  
8 traveled with members of her church to Russia to work at orphanages;  
9 a graduate of Uplift North Hills Preparatory in Irving, she went on  
10 to receive a business degree from Syracuse University; and

11           WHEREAS, Following her college graduation, Ms. Bryant lived  
12 and worked in New York City and Dallas; she later relocated to  
13 Washington, D.C., and earned a master's degree in international  
14 affairs at American University; over the course of her studies, she  
15 served as a research assistant in the country of Georgia, visited  
16 Turkey, and became fluent in Russian after taking language  
17 immersion courses at universities in Moscow and St. Petersburg;  
18 ultimately, she was employed at the World Bank; and

19           WHEREAS, Possessed of a keen intellect and an insatiable  
20 curiosity, Ms. Bryant was passionate about traveling, writing, and  
21 reading and especially enjoyed philosophical and foreign  
22 literature; moreover, she shared a deep love of music with her three  
23 siblings, Clayton, Jonathan, and Patrick; and

24           WHEREAS, Although Michelle Bryant will be deeply missed, she

1 has left her loved ones with a wealth of memories that they will  
2 forever treasure; now, therefore, be it

3         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Kristen Michelle
