- 15 facilities form the backbone of the rural Texas telecommunications
- 16 network, enabling voice and wireless calls, broadband, and a range

- 20 suppliers, and other rural Texas businesses; working tirelessly
- 21 during adversity, rural phone companies and their technicians have

- 23 challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic; moreover, during Winter Storm
- 24 Uri in 2021, technicians braved dangerous conditions, often
